Symmetry Shield RP₁₈, 4.6 x 20 mm, 3.5 μm IS

Part numbers:

Symmetry - 186002090

Symmetry Shield - 186002092

Mobile phase A:

0.1% HCOOH in Water

Mobile phase B: 0.1% HCOOH in ACN

Flow rate: 3.0 mL/min

Injection volume: 10 μ L

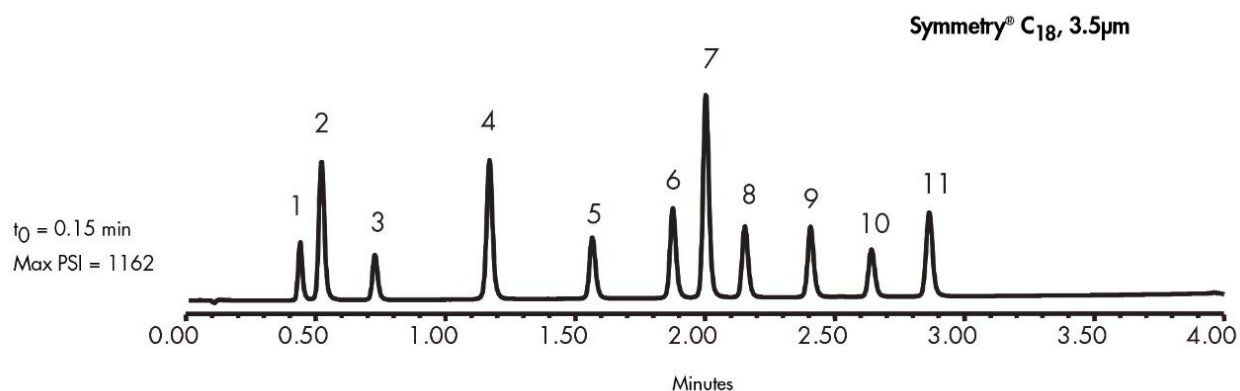

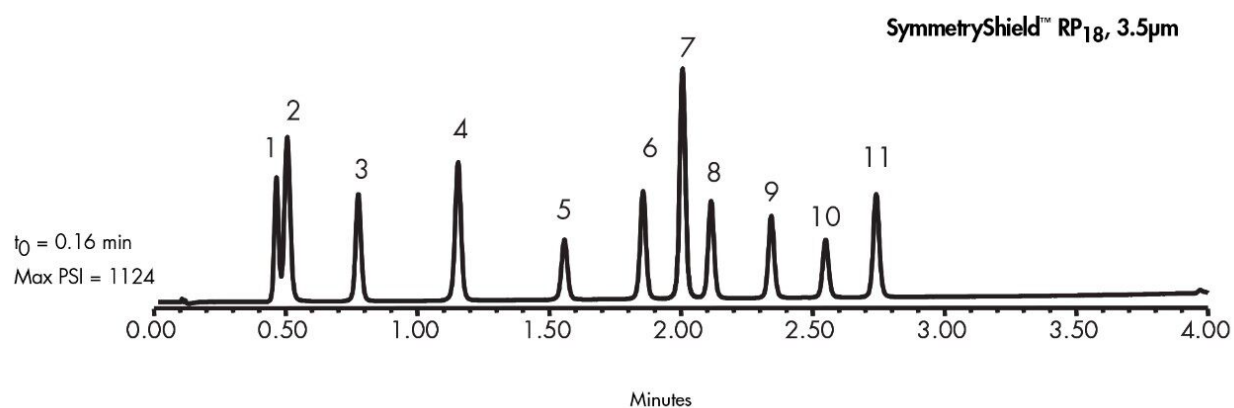
