
1. Niacinamide

2. Calcium Pantothenate






4. Pyrodoxine Hydrochloride



5. Pyridoxamine Dihydrochloride




7. Thiamine Hydrochloride

Experimental

HPLC Method

Column:	Symmetry C ₁₈ , 3.9 x 150 mm, 5 µm
Part numbers:	Column - WAT046980, PIC B6 - WAT084199
Mobile phase:	20 mM PIC B6 (hexane sulfonic acid) and 0.1% phosphoric acid, pH 2.2/methanol 75:25
Flow rate:	0.7 mL/min
Injection volume:	10 μL of mixture with component 1 at 11 μg/mL, 2 at 133 μg/mL, 3 at 17 μg/mL, 4 at 6 μg/mL, 5 at 25 μg/mL, 6 at 34 μg/mL, and 7 at 67 μg/mL
Detection:	UV @ 210 nm
