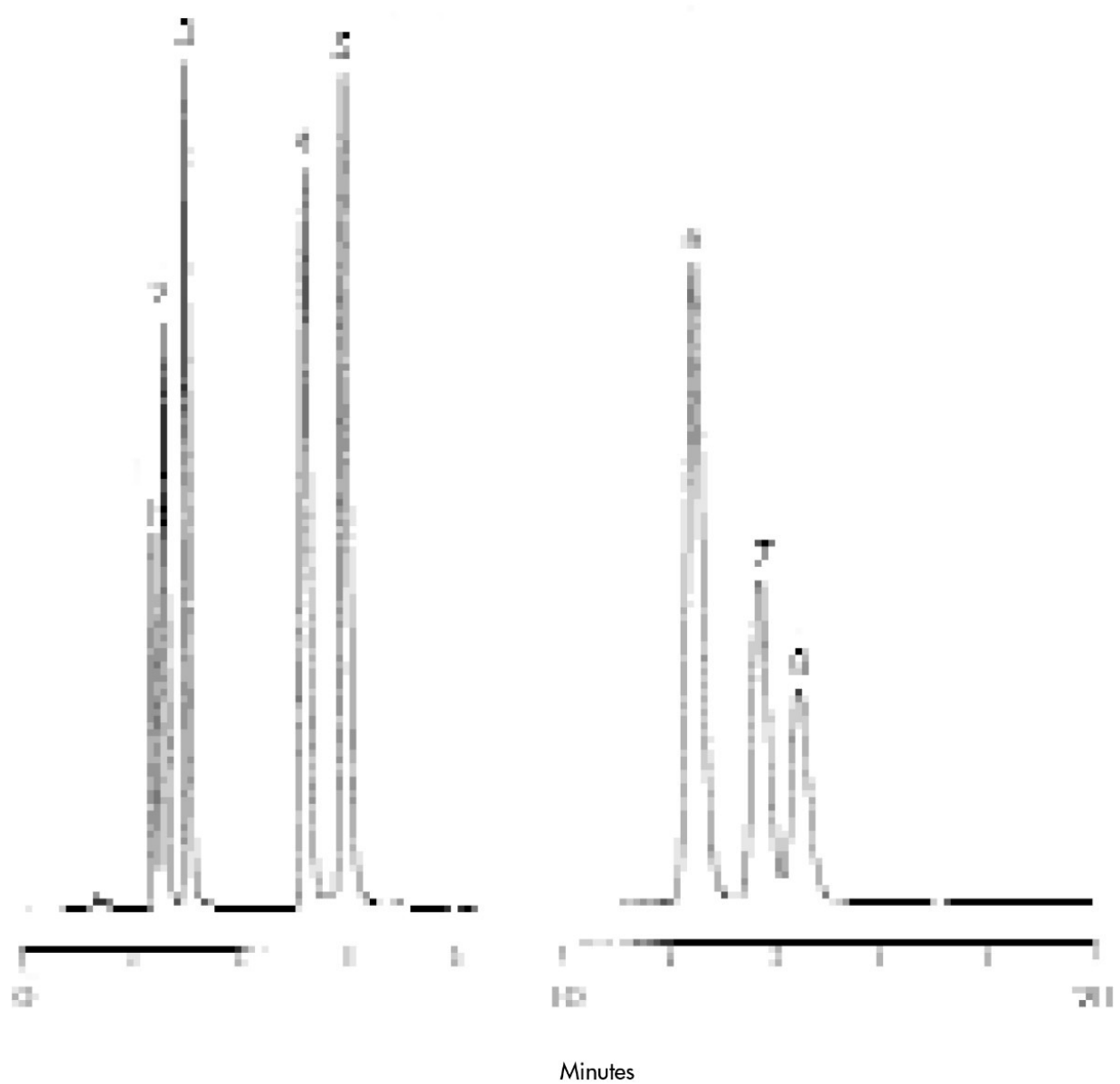
HPLC Method

Column:	Symmetry C ₈ , 3.9 x 150 mm, 5 µm
Guard column:	Symmetry Guard Column 3.9 x 20 mm, 5 µm
Part numbers:	Column - WAT046970, Guard - WAT054250
Mobile phase:	100 mM potassium phosphate, pH 6.9/acetonitrile/methanol/water 17:25:5:53
Flow rate:	1.0 mL/min
Injection volume:	5 µL of 25µg/mL sample
Detection:	UV @ 214 nm
