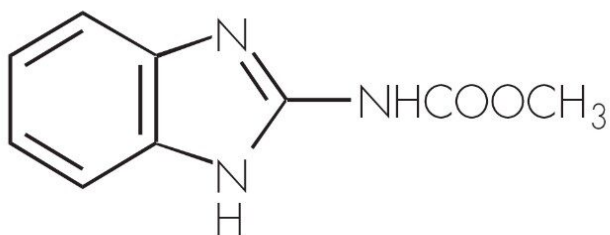

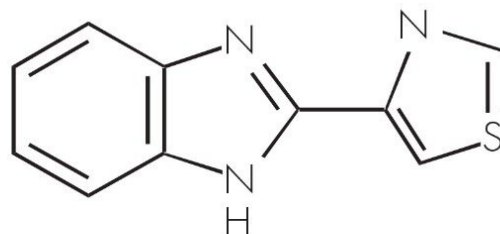
This application brief demonstrates analysis of fungicides in orange juice.

THIABENDAZOLE

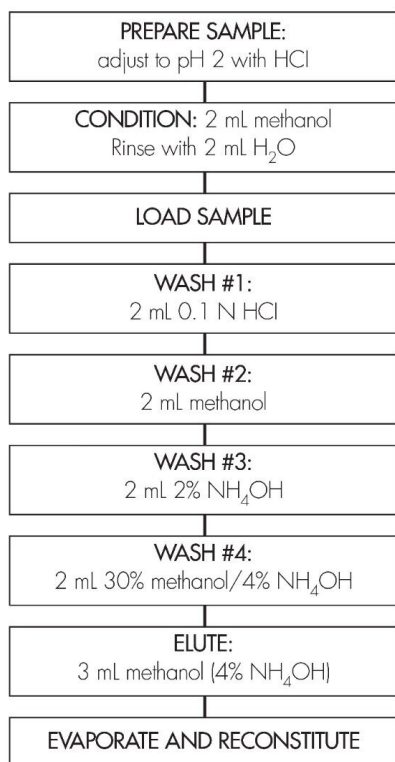

Column:	Xterra RP ₁₈ , 4.6 x 100 mm, 3.5 μm
Part number:	186000438
Mobile phase:	72.5% $\text{KH}_2\text{PO}_4/\text{K}_2\text{HPO}_4$ (20 mM pH 6.8) 27.5% CH_3CN
Flow rate:	1 mL/min
Injection volume:	20 μL
Detection:	PDA (288 nm)

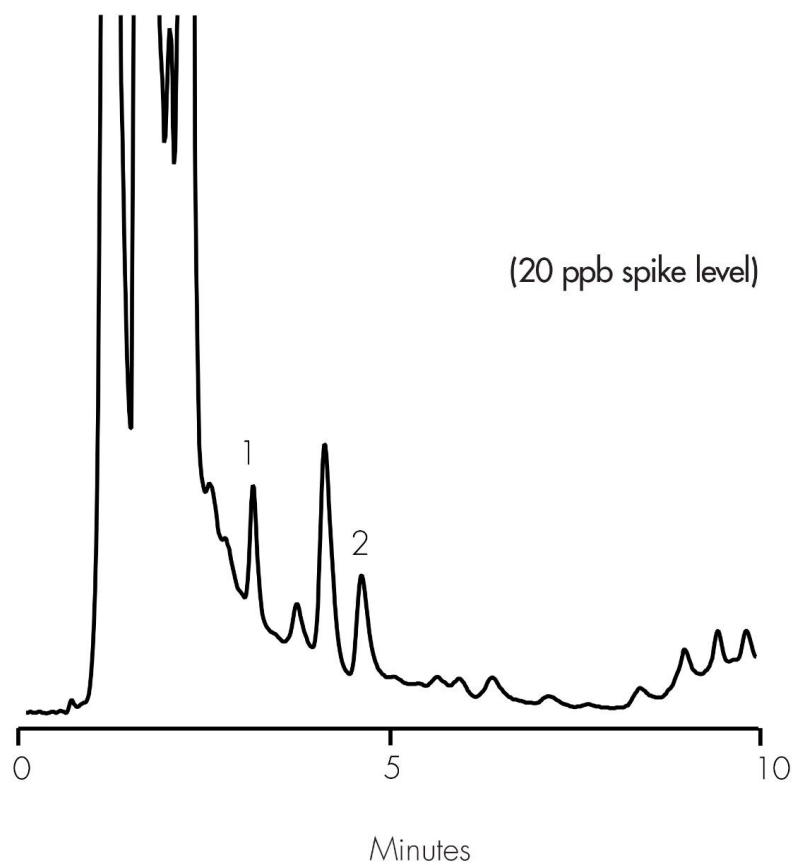

2. Thiabendazole	94% (3% RSD)
