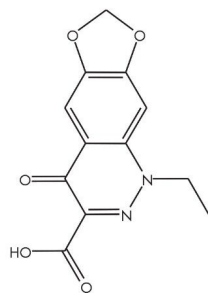

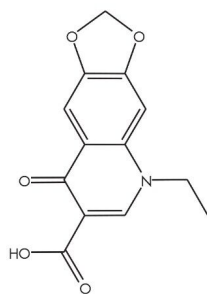

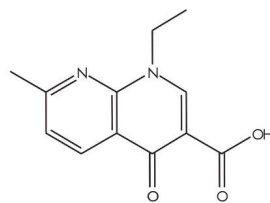

Nalidixic acid

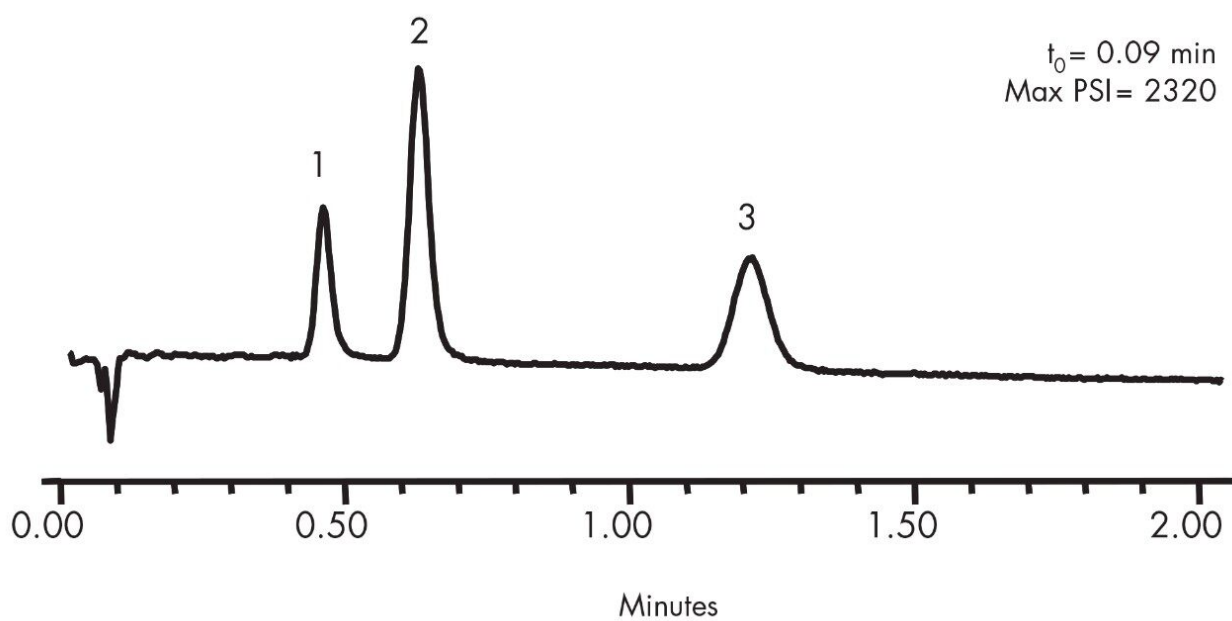

Conditions

Column:	Atlantis dC ₁₈ , 4.6 x 20 mm /S, 3 µm, (p/n: 186002062)
Mobile phase A:	Water
Mobile phase B:	Methanol

Mobile phase C:	Acetonitrile
Mobile phase D:	1% HCOOH, pH 2.23
Flow rate:	4 mL/min
Isocratic mobile-phase composition:	55% A, 30% B, 5% C, 10% D
Injection volume:	5 µL
Sample concentration:	5 µg/mL
Temperature:	30 °C
Detection:	UV @ 254 nm
