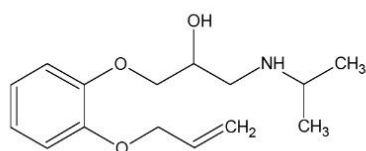

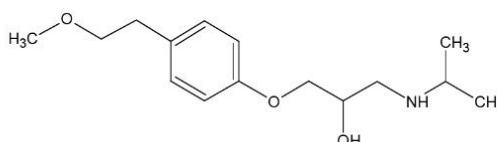

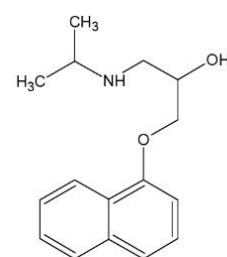
1. Metoprolol (50 mg/mL)

Metoprolol



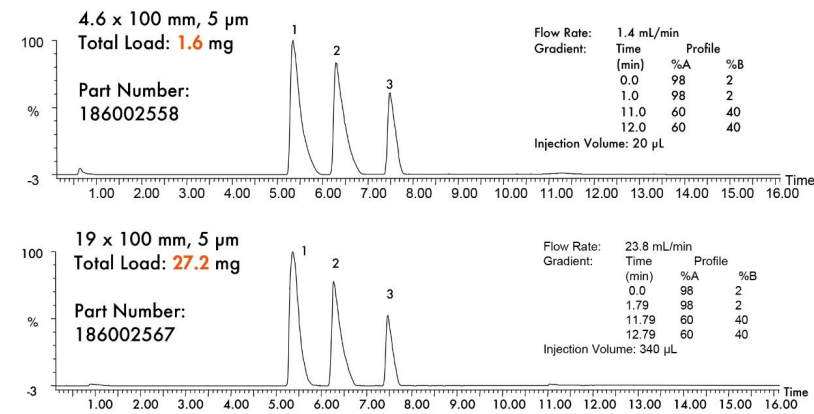

Mobile phase A:	0.1% HCOOH in Water
Mobile phase B:	0.1% HCOOH in ACN
Temperature:	Ambient
Detection:	UV @ 254 nm
