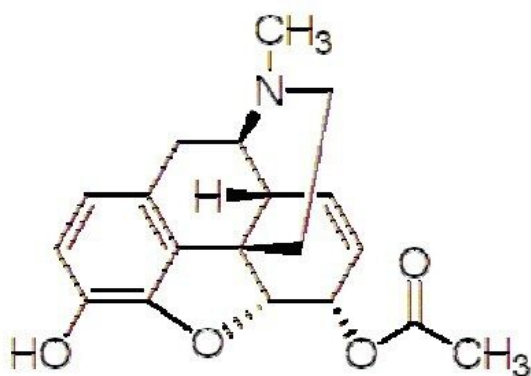
Abstract

This application brief demonstrates the LC-MS gradient separation of 6-acetylmorphine and morphine on XBridge HILIC Columns.

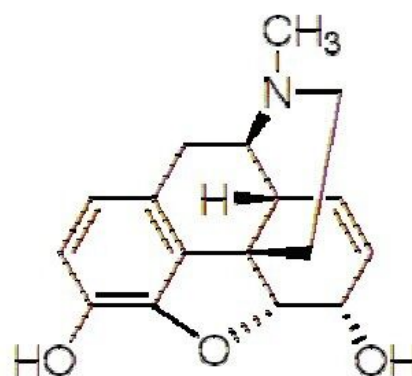
Introduction

LC Conditions

Column:	XBridge HILIC, 2.1 x 100 mm, 3.5 μ m
Part number:	186004433
Mobile phase A:	10 mM NH ₄ COOH with 0.125% formic acid in 50:50 ACN:H ₂ O
Mobile phase B:	10 mM NH ₄ COOH with 0.125% formic acid in 90:10 ACN:H ₂ O
Flow rate:	0.6 mL/min
Sample concentration:	10 ng/mL each
Injection volume:	10.0 μ L (PLNO, 20 μ L loop)
Strong and weak needle wash:	95:5 ACN:H ₂ O
Column temperature:	30 °C
Detection:	MS
Instrument:	Waters ACQUITY UPLC with TQD

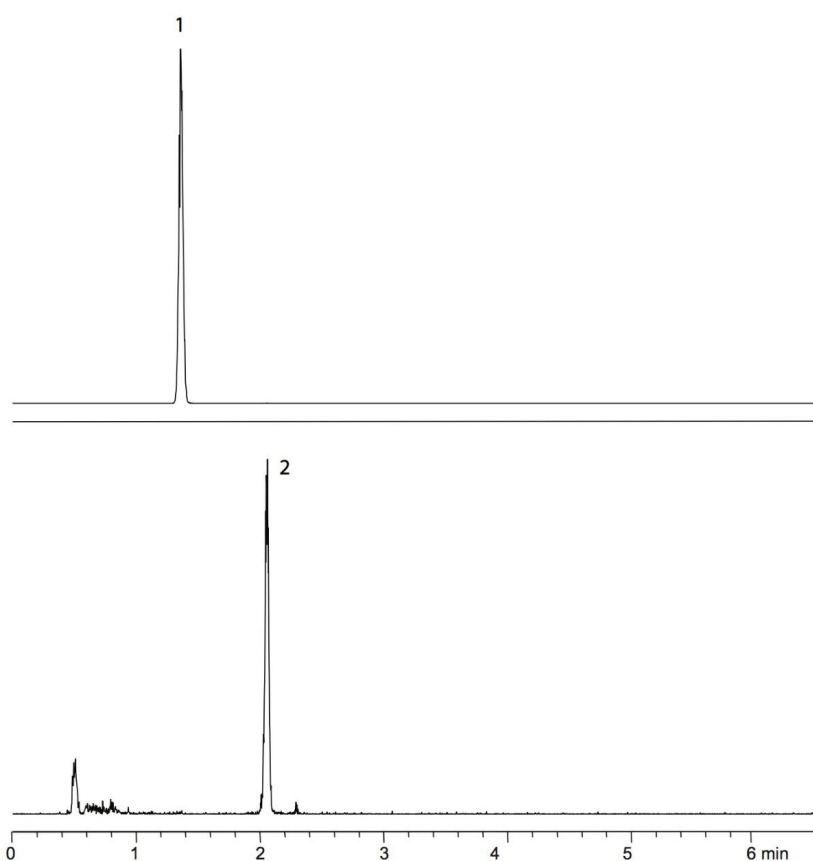
